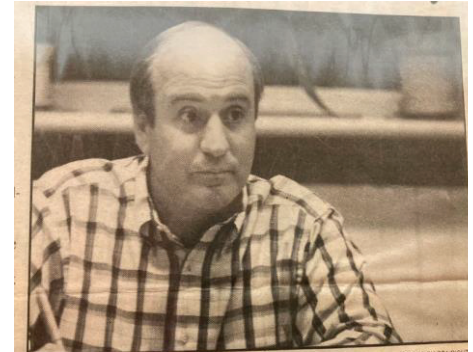

The Sherborn Garden Club celebrated the 100th Birthday of founding member Phyllis Braun in style at their "Floral Feast for the Eyes" event on March 12th at the Sherborn Community Center.



FARMER BRAUN -- Friends of the Sherborn Library will present a talk by Phyllis Braun on April 8 at 8 p.m. Planting and organic farming will be discussed. The Braun family has farmed in Sherborn, on Western Avenue, for 25 years and raises sheep and chickens. In recent years they've expanded to organic gardening and herbs. Mrs. Braun plans their acreage for organic growing by using the companion plant system and the uses of herbs. All produce sold on the farm. 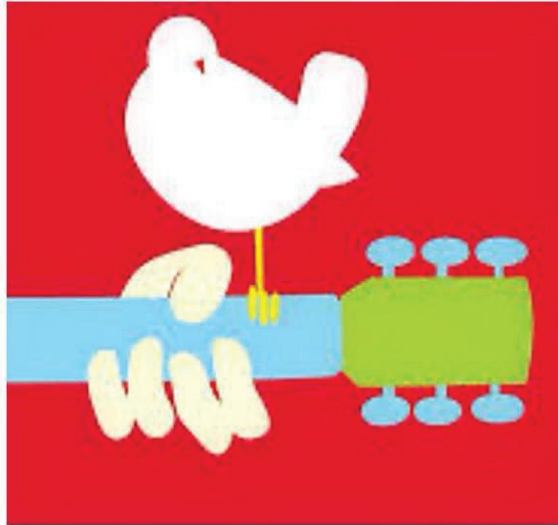

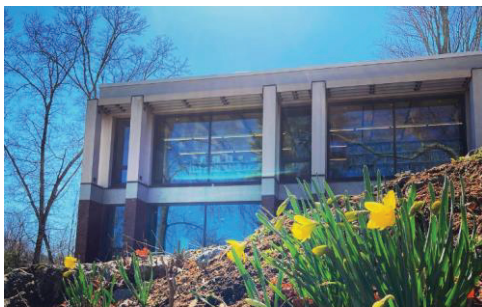
